
OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

What about the outcome?




Each quarter we like to update you with outcomes and exciting news that has come to our attention!

We have a participant who has accomplished several goals throughout the course of the program. He has gained stable employment earning a living wage and he has purchased a new vehicle to eliminate a transportation barrier. He also received another raise in pay and has been spending quality time with his son.

Another participant has worked with Iowa works to build a resume and brush up her interview skills. She has become more aware of her strengths and learned how to identify when she needs help and to ask for it.
